CECE 2014 - 11th International Interdisciplinary Meeting on Bioanalysis

International Interdisciplinary Meeting on Bioanalysis – CECE 2014 took place in Brno in the term October 20 – 22, 2014. This year was dedicated to Prof. Jaroslav Janák, the founder of the Institute of Analytical Chemistry AV ČR, on the occasion of his 90th birthday. CECE 2014 dealt with separation techniques and related themes like MS, microfluidic devices and miniaturization.



The presentations of the young scientists (CECE junior) were held on the first day. The poster sessions and invited lectures were held on the second and third days of the conference. Total of 22 CECE junior lectures, 16 invited lectures and 113 posters were presented. Among the important speakers on the field of capillary electrophoresis were Andras Guttman, Salvatore Fanali, Mihkel Kaljurand or Pier-Giorgio

Righetti.

Our results were presented within the poster session. The posters topics dealt with Mir-124 determination employing magnetic particles and quantum dots (Šmerková) and Identification of human microbiome in hard-to-heal wounds by MALDI-TOF MS and sequencing (Dostálová).
